Lantana's Energy Efficiency Grants

* PBC-\$217,680 for Police Annex Renovation

- Florida Energy Grant \$341,000 to develop energy improvements financing program for commercial properties
- * EECBG-\$1,238,300 for 5-city MECC Energy Audits, Greenhouse Gas, Improvements to Buildings & Facilities, Planning policies

Palm Beach Grant Local Grant Program

- Awarded \$217,680 to add Energy Efficiency Improvements to Police Annex Building Renovation
 - * 10 kV Solar Array sell power back to FPL
 - * High SEER HVAC system & use condensate for toilet
 - * Two 500-gallon cisterns for irrigation

 - * Pay for energy improvements through assessment on tax bill
